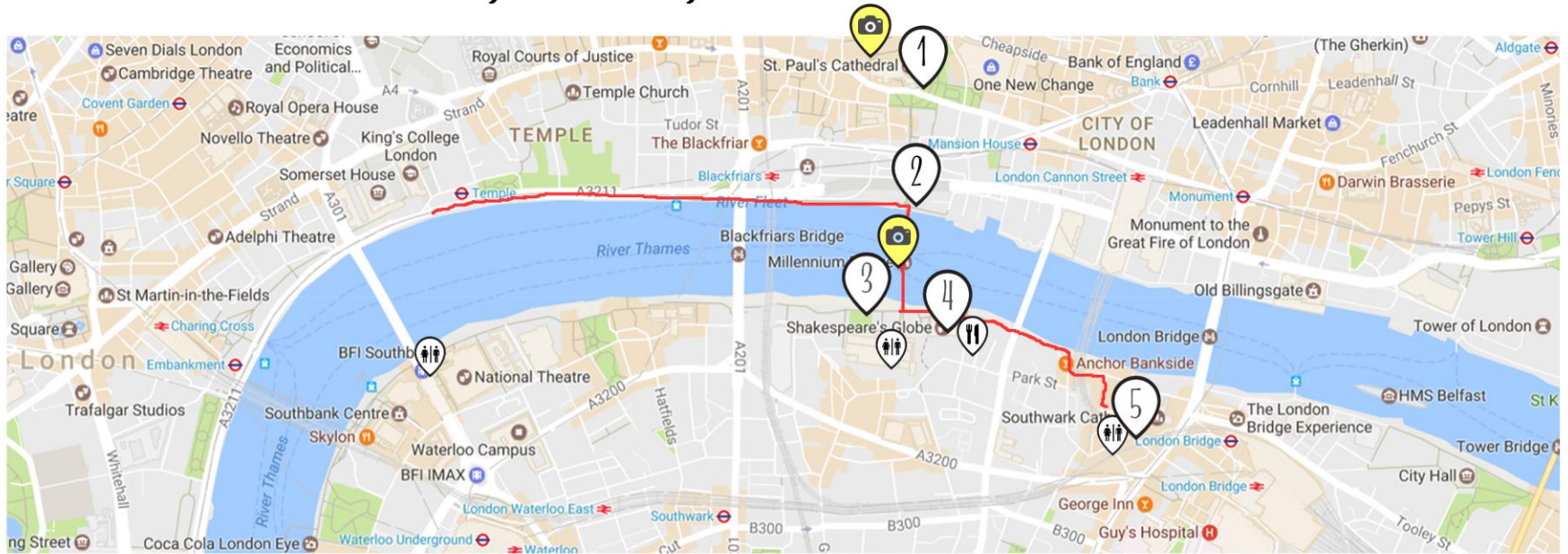


Grand Family Getaways WALKING TO BOROUGH MARKET

You can begin this walk anywhere along the north side of the Thames from Embankment Station to Blackfriars bridge. On the west side of Blackfriars bridge there is a ramp that leads to a pedestrian only walking path that will take you to St. Paul's Cathedral and the Millennium pedestrian bridge. When you get to the Millennium Bridge, take the steps up or there is an inclinator (a diagonal elevator) that will take you up to the level of the bridge and St. Paul's Cathedral. If you want to walk to the cathedral there is a short path that takes you there. Otherwise, walk across the bridge. The bridge offers some great photo opportunities with the cathedral in the background. Once you cross the bridge the Tate Modern art museum is right there. If you need bathrooms there are nice ones inside. It is free to get in, and the art museum is pretty world class, too. Alternatively, just after you walk past Shakespeare's Globe (another great photo spot) there will be a Starbucks and shortly thereafter several other coffee shops which have restrooms. The pedestrian path will continue under a railroad bridge. Keep walking along the path by the river. You will come to the Anchor pub. Turn right onto Park Street for a few meters before turning left onto Clink Street and going under the tunnel. Then you will take your first right, Storey Street, which will lead you to Borough Market.
